RESCINDING BYLAW NO. 1617

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CARDSTON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESCINDING BYLAW NO. 1590.

WHEREAS, Bylaw No. 1590, a bylaw to collect an off-site levy was given third reading on 22 March 2011; and

WHEREAS, Bylaw No. 1590 provided for the levying of off-site costs attributable to land development whether as an individual parcel or as a subdivided lot(s) to be collected at the time of subdivision or development; and

WHEREAS, Council deems that it is no longer necessary to charge and collect an off-site levy in consistency with those terms as described in Bylaw No. 1590;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council for the Town of Cardston in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:


1. That Bylaw No. 1590 is hereby repealed upon this bylaw coming into effect.
2. This bylaw shall come into effect upon third and final reading hereof.
