

A By-Law of the Town of Cardston for the purpose of closing to public travel and creating title to, and disposing of portions of a public walkway. In accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26. 1, revised statutes of Alberta 1994, as amended.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the walkway closed and sold, and the roadway closed, selling a portion of said roadway and reopening the roadway by a new plan of subdivision

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Cardston deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain walkways, roadways or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and there-
After creating title to and disposing of same, and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Cardston in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and creates title to and disposes of the following described walkway subject to Rights of access granted by other legislation:

Walkway located in Plan 7710921 Block 4 and the entire roadway in the same plan, and block 7th Avenue West commencing at 5th Street West (roadway to be reopened by plan of subdivision)
