BY-LAW #1508

A Bylaw of the Town of Cardston in the Province of Alberta to amend Bylaw 1369 the Water, Sewer and Storm Sewer Rates Bylaw, Bylaw 1484, the Electrical Rates Bylaw and Bylaw 1496, the Garbage Bylaw.

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1994 being Chapter M-26.1 and amendments thereto, The Town of Cardston enacts the following

1. Owner's Responsibility to Obtain Utility Service

- a. The owner of a property shall be responsible for entering into a water, sewer, electrical and garbage utility supply contract with the Town of Cardston as soon as a building on the owner's property is occupied or otherwise in use.
- b. In case of rental of revenue properties, the owner of the property, not any tenant, shall be responsible for entering into a water, sewer, electrical and garbage utility supply contract with the Town of Cardston as soon as a building on the owner's property is occupied or otherwise in use.
- 2. That this Bylaw shall take effect January 1, 2000.
