

By-Law 1501 ✓

A By-law of the Town of Cardston in the Province of Alberta to pass a "Local Improvement law".

By virtue of Section 397 & 398 of the M.G.A., 1994, Chapter M-26.1 and amendments thereto. The Mayor and Council of the Town of Cardston duly enact as follows:

Local Improvement By-law.

This local improvement is for development of a roadway at 10th street west commencing at 124.88 feet south of Second Avenue, continuing to the dead end at the north property boundary. Plan 8112665, Block 1, Lot 15.

The pay period commences at the time of development and shall be 1/4 paid within 30 days of development application and the balance due in equal installments over the next three years.


The local improvement will be assessed at \$1,250.00 per parcel. The total estimated cost of the improvement is \$52,652.81.
