

BY-LAW # 1502

A By-Law of the Town of Cardston for the purpose of closing to public travel and (creating title to, and disposing of) portions of a public highway in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26.1, revised statutes of Alberta 1994, as amended.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have a portion of highway closed, and sold

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Cardston deems it expedient provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to and disposing of same, and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by a person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Cardston the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and create title to and disposes of the following described highways, subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation:

Plan 9110755

Portion of 10th Street West described as "the most southerly 25 meters of the most westerly 20 meters" containing 0.05 hectares (0.12 acres) or less.
