

A By-Law of the Town of Cardston to provide a Waste Collection Service for the Town.

Pursuant to section 45 & 46 of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1994, Chapter M-26.1, as amendments thereto, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Cardston, duly assembled, enacts the following:

1. The Town of Cardston either through its own forces, or through an outside contract, establishes a waste collection system in Cardston.
2. The Town may enter into an agreement with a person, company, organization to provide said waste collection.
3. When the Town contracts a person, company, organization, etc. to provide a waste collection service, by virtue of the same prohibits any other person from providing the same or similar service in all or part of the municipality.
4. Any person who is found guilty of an infraction of this By-law shall be subject to the penalties as outlined in the General Penalty By-law #1353 of the Town of Cardston, which is in effect at the time of the offence.


This By-law shall come into force upon passing of the Third and Final reading.
