

BY-LAW # 1516 A

A By-Law to amend By-Law 1516 of the Town of Cardston in the Province of Alberta to provide for distribution of Electricity and to be called the Distribution Access Tariff By-Law.

Whereas the Government of Alberta has enacted changes to the Electric Utilities Act in relation to Electrical Deregulation in the Province of Alberta, Section 31.91 of the Act, Distribution Tariff Regulation dated the 8th day of May, 2000 and amendments thereto, grant the Municipality certain rights and powers concerning the ownership of electrical distribution systems and its use, and inspection of electrical wiring and

Whereas it is expedient to make amendments to the provisions for the management and control of the Electrical System of the Town of Cardston, and to provide rules and regulations regarding the use of electricity and the provision of electrical distribution services and to establish a Distribution Tariff of system access serve, distribution access service of electrical rates and charges,

Now therefore, the Council of the Town of Cardston duly assembled enacts as follows:

- A. That the Retail Access Services Agreement form part of Bylaw 1516
- B. That Schedule B "Terms and Conditions for Consumers Service" be replaced by Town of Cardston Power Distribution Tariff Terms and Conditions and be included and form part of By-Law 1516
- C. This By-Law shall come into force January 1, 2005.
