

BY-LAW #1521

A By-Law in the Town of Cardston, in the Province of Alberta to rescind By-Law 1314, known as the Sunday Closing By-Law.

Pursuant to Section 7, and 191 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26.1, Statute of Alberta, 1994, with amendments in force as of September 1, 2000, The Town of Cardston, duly assembled, enacts this by-law.

Whereas, the Town has received legal opinion regarding the Town's Sunday Closing By-Law #1314 and this legal opinion has stated that municipalities do not have the authority to pass by-laws based on moral issues and that this power is vested in the Federal Government.


And Whereas an option to write a by-Law for a "day of rest" in seven would not serve the community.

Therefore be it resolved that By-Law 1314 be rescinded.
