

A By-Law of the Town of Cardston for the purpose of closing to public travel and creating title to a portion of a roadway. In accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26.1, revised statutes of Alberta 1994, as amended.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the portion of roadway closed and sold, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Cardston deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roadways or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to and disposing of same, and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Cardston in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and creates title to and disposes of the following described roadway subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

“Plan 4937 I.

That portion of Simmons Street (11th Street West) bounded on the South by the production Westerly of the South limit of Lot 2, Block 6, Plan 4937 I. A distance of 10.0 metres.

Thence Northerly and parallel to the West limit of Lot 1 and 2, Block 6, Plan 4937 I. A distance of 69.17 metres.

Thence North Easterly to a point marking the South limit of Road Plan 7910851 with the West limit of Lot 1, Block 6, Plan 4937 I.

Thence Southerly along the West limit of Lots 1 and 2, Block 6, Plan 4937 I. to the point of commencement.


Area herewith contained is 0.074 Hectares (0.18 acres) more or less.”


