

By-Law #1526 A ✓

**A By-law of the Town of Cardston, in the Province of Alberta, to amend By-Law #1526, establishing a Tourism and Economic Development Board.**

Now therefore, under the provisions of section 146 (b) of the Municipal Government Act, being chapter 26.1 of the revised Statutes of Alberta 1997, the Mayor and Council duly assembled enacts the following:

Composition of the Board


The Tourism and Economic Development Board shall consist of nine members with representation as follows:

- 1 - Town of Cardston Council Member
- 1 - Chamber of Commerce Representative
- 1 - Golf Course Committee Member
- 1 - Remington Carriage Museum Representative
- 3 - Members at large (Adult Residents of the Town of Cardston who shall be appointed by resolution of the Town of Cardston Council)
- 2 - Cardston County Representatives (Adult Residents of the Cardston County who shall be appointed by resolution of the Town of Cardston Council)
