## Bylaw #1552

A Bylaw of the Town of Cardston to Designate the Grotto Pizza – formerly the Bank Of Montreal building and referred to as such as a Municipal Historic Resource.

**WHEREAS** Section 26 of the Historical Resources Act, Revised Statues of Alberta 2000, c.H-9, as amended, permits Council to designate any historic resource within the Town of Cardston whose preservation Council considers to be in the public interest, together with any land in or on which it is located, as a Municipal Historic Resource:

**AND WHEREAS** the preservation of the "Bank of Montreal building" in the Town of Cardston appears to be in the public interest;

**AND WHEREAS** the owners of the "Bank of Montreal Building" have agreed to waive compensation now and in the future;

**NOW THEREFORE,** THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CARDSTON DULY ASSEMBLED HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

"The Bank of Montreal Building PTN Lot #1, Block #34, Plan #1793E with the civic address of 29  $2^{nd}$  Ave. West is hereby designated as a Municipal Historic Resource"
