New Bylaw No. 1553

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CARDSTON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO PROVIDE FOR DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRICITY AND IS TO BE CALLED THE ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION BYLAW.

Pursuant to the Municipal Government act, Chapter M 26.1 Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto; and pursuant to the Electric Utilities Act RSA 2000 and regulation pertaining to that Act, and that these Acts and Regulation grant the Municipality certain rights and powers concerning the ownership of electrical distribution systems and its use.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make provisions for the management and control of the Electrical System of the Town of Cardston, and to provide rules and regulations regarding the use of electricity and the provision of electrical distributions services and to establish a Distribution Tariff, distribution access services of electrical rates and charges, and a Regulated Rate Tariff;

Now therefore, the Council of the Town of Cardston, duly assembled, enacts as fallows:

- A. That Bylaw 1516 and amendments thereto, be rescinded as of December 31, 2005. That the rates hereto attached and forming Schedule "A" Distribution Tariff be approved to commence January 1, 2006.
- B. That Schedule "B" Terms and Conditions for Distribution Tariff, Consumer and Retail Services be included and form part of this Bylaw.
- C. That Schedule "C" Cardston Power Distribution Tariff Fee Schedule Regulated Rate Tariff RRT and form part of this Bylaw.
- D. That Schedule "D" The Regulated Rate Tariff shall be included and form part of this Bylaw.
- E. That Schedule "E" the Retail Access Service Agreement form part of this Bylaw.
- F. That Schedule "F" the ENMAX Systems Acceptable Use Policy form part of this Bylaw.
- G. That the Town of Cardston engage the services of ENMAX Power Corporation to provide services as outlined in the Contract for Wire Services dated January 1, 2006.
- H. That the Town of Cardston engage the services of ENMAX Energy Corporation to provide services a outlined in the Contract for Services dated January 1, 2006.

This Bylaw shall come in force January 1, 2006 and Bylaw 1516 and amendments there to shall be rescinded.
