Bylaw #1560

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF CARDSTON FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND SALE OF PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M26.1, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1994, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the roadway closed, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Cardston deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain travel certain roads or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality and thereafter leasing of same and

WHEREAS, notice of intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Cardston in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and leasing of the following described highways, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:


**Firstly:** THAT PORTION OF 10<sup>TH</sup> "A" STREET WEST BEING THE NORTH WESTERLY CUT-OFF ON LOT 3-MR, BLOCK 2, PLAN 791 0693 CONTAINING 134 SQUARE FEET more or less.

**Secondly:** THAT PORTION OF 10<sup>TH</sup> STREET WEST BEING THE NORTH EASTERLY CUT-OFF ON LOT 1, BLOCK 2, PLAN 791 0693 CONTAINING 134 SQUARE FEET more or less.

**Thirdly:** THE SOUTHERLY 15.1 FEET IN PERPENDICULAR WIDTH THROUGHOUT OF 2<sup>ND</sup> AVENUE ON PLAN 741 0569, LYING TO THE NORTH OF BLOCK 2, PLAN 791 0683 CONTAINING 2168 SQUARE FEET more or less.




