

BY-LAW # 1562

A By-Law of the Town of Cardston for the purpose of closing to public travel and disposing of portions of a public highway in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, as amended.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer require for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the roadway closed, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Cardston deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality and thereafter disposing of the same, and


WHEREAS, notice of intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that Council of the Town of Cardston in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and disposing of the following described highways, subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation:


Plan 4937 I

of the east boundary of Block 11 and
to the West of the Northerly production
of the West boundary of Block 11 all on said plan
containing 0.516 Hectares (1.275 Acres) more or less.




