

By-Law #1568 B

A By-Law of the Town of Cardston, in the Province of Alberta to amend By-Law #1568A the Business License By-Law.

Under authority of the Municipal Government Act, R SA 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Cardston in the Province of Alberta in Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

Part VIII License Fees

- 33. k. Administration charges will be charged for any license transfers, license changes, a copy of a current business license, or for any application to the Planning Commission for approval of a discretionary business.
 - iv) The fee for submitting an application to the Planning Commission will be as per the Land Use By-Law #1581 and any amendments thereto. If the application is approved, this fee will be applied towards the cost of the development permit required. If the application is denied, the application fee will not be refunded. The Business License fee as per Part VIII, Section 33 will also be required at time of approval.

These amendments shall come into force upon this By-Law receiving the Third and Final Reading.
