- 1. Commercial Customers are eligible for this rate if a reasonable forecast of the customer's annual consumption of electric energy at a site is less than 250 MWh.
- 2. This rate applies to all commercial customers which obtain Small Commercial (Commercial/Industrial Service <50 kVA) Service pursuant to the Town of Cardston Distribution Tariff.
